## **Eligibility Requirements**

Winneshiek Medical Center assesses a patient's eligibility for financial assistance based on a combination of a patient's household income, household size and overall assets to get a picture of the patient's overall financial condition. We request proof of all of these items in the form of tax documents, bank documents and any other documents that support the patient's statements about their need for financial assistance.

Once financial need is established, WMC uses a sliding scale to determine the level of financial assistance. The amount of assistance is dependent on the patient's income and household size. WMC may provide full or partial assistance, for any patient whose income is between 100% and 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines published annually on the US Department of Health and Human Services website: <a href="https://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty-guidelines">https://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty-guidelines</a>.

## **Basis for Calculating the Amounts Charged to Patients**

Amounts charged for emergency and medically necessary medical services to patients eligible for Financial Assistance will not be more than the amount generally billed (AGB) to individuals with insurance covering such care. The amount the patient is personally responsible for paying after deductions, discounts and insurance have been applied is determined by charges for similar services over the previous 12 months.
